## Cracking The Code!

Navigating the waters of the teenage years is messy! Many times teens shut you down and you are left to figure out the cryptic code placed before you. Often, parents feel like the code is too difficult to crack and become combative with their teen. At times, it seems most effective & expedient to lecture, yell, and tell!

I'd like to suggest there is a better way to crack this code.

What if you put on your detective hat and became curious about your teen and their world? Now, I'm not talking about interrogations like you see on television, although that is often our first stop! I'm suggesting that you become a detached observer who is gathering facts, remembering you cannot crack the code without facts!

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is through listening and observing. Listening to discover and to truly hear what clues get dropped during the conversation. We are not listening to speak, lecture, criticize or solve the problem. We are listening to understand. We are listening and looking for clues about emotions that are under the surface, unspoken struggles, unspoken conflicts or problems that they are trying to figure out.

Our teens are longing for independence and belonging. They want to solve their problems, but often don't know the proper steps to take. What if the cryptic code was just a symptom of what is going on in their minds? What if instead of taking it personally, we were open and curious, being a support for our teen who empowers them to think and learn on their own?

What should our role be during the fact gathering mission?

- 1. Showing interest in their world makes room for you to help them figure things out. Our position as parents does not automatically grant us influence in our teen's lives.
- 2. Most times you will find that they just need to think through some things.
- 3. This happens not by giving them the answers, but by asking them powerful questions to help them engage the Prefrontal cortex (the problem solving area of the brain).
- 4. By doing this, you are equipping them to

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have a growth mindset.

Imagine for a moment having a problem. It has you a bit sullen as you try to figure it out when suddenly your friend stops in for a visit. She observes you and says, "What's wrong with you?" When you tell her she proceeds to lecture you and try to fix your problem, criticizing your attempts to solve the problem on your own. How would that make you feel? Sadly, that is how we approach our sullen teens.

When we approach our teens with curiosity, mutual respect and as an open and safe place to learn, we do to them what we would like others to do for us.
